JOIN APWU PRESIDENT JONATHAN SMITH'S FIRST LIVESTREAM EVENT

APWU President Jonathan Smith will hold his first livestream event at 7 p.m. ET on Tuesday, Feb. 10. The hour-long livestream will address the safety challenges postal workers face every day and how the APWU is ready to hold management accountable for our right to a safe and healthy workplace.

Historically, more work-related deaths occur due to industrial accidents at the Postal Service than all other federal agencies combined. From extreme weather conditions and mechanical hazards to mental health support and dignity on the job, President Smith is going to dig into how we can all take part in protecting each other. He will discuss how to report unsafe conditions and practices using PS-Form 1767, explore

postal workers' right to a safe workplace, and discuss the fundamentals of safety for protecting yourself and your coworkers – and making sure management does their part too.

The event will also include a live “Questions and Answers” segment for attendees who wish to engage with the president and panelists.
